

D. DRESS CODE

P.E. Uniform—PK3-8th

- Navy blue nylon mesh shorts with **light blue or gray T-shirt** with school logo
- Sneakers and white socks – only worn on P.E. days
- **Navy blue** sweatshirt and sweatpants with school logo - when the weather turns cold
- Full PE uniform available at **New Bern Sporting Goods**

Mass Uniform-PK3-4th Grade Wednesday

- Boys Navy Blue or Khaki Uniform pants, with white or light blue button down oxford shirt with logo (Belt required with pants-grades 1st-4th.)
- Girls - Plaid jumper with white Peter Pan collar blouse (long or short sleeve,) navy blue crew neck cardigan sweater or fleece jacket when appropriate (School logo on jacket required)
- **Blue, black, or brown** dress shoe (**No canvas or tennis shoes.**)
- Plain white or navy blue tights or socks (knee high or fold over)
- Jacket logo available at New Bern Sporting Goods

Mass Uniform- 5-8th Grade Wednesday

- Boys Navy Blue or Khaki Uniform pants, with white or light blue button down oxford shirt with logo (Belt required with pants).
- Girls navy blue, khaki, or plaid skirt/skort with white or light blue button down oxford shirt
- School sweater or fleece jacket when appropriate (Logo on jacket required)
- **Blue, black, or brown** dress shoes (**No canvas or tennis shoes.**)
- Plain white or navy blue tights or socks (knee high or fold over)

The following items can be worn on non Mass or PE days.

Girls & Boys- 3K Year-old to Grade 8th Grade

- Navy Blue or Khaki uniform shorts.
- Girls may follow same pant options as boys
- Plaid skort. White peter pan collar blouse. (PK3-8th)
- White or light blue polo shirt with school logo in long or short sleeves.
- Navy blue crew neck cardigan sweater or navy blue V-neck pullover sweater with or without white striping, or sweater vest with or without white striping.
- Navy blue fleece jacket, with or without sleeves, and school logo
- Solid blue, black, or brown belt - no logos or decorations allowed
- Plain white or navy blue tights or socks (girls)
- Plain white or navy blue socks (boys)
- Athletic shoes

Additional Uniform Guidelines

- Only school sweaters or fleece jackets may be worn in the classroom.
- Dress shoes are to be oxford, saddle, Maryjane's, or loafer in style. No sandals, flip-flops, boots, high top shoes, or raised heels are permitted at any time during the school year.

- All students are to be neat and well groomed. Hair should be clean and combed. The maximum acceptable hair length for boys is above the eyebrows, not touching the collar at the back, and trimmed above and around the ears at the sides. Hair must be cut — not pushed back—to meet this requirement.
- Hair dyed unnatural colors, ponytails on boys, and shaved designs in the hair are not permitted. A simple hairstyle is required. The school administration reserves the right to control the extremes in hairstyles and colors.
- For girls, the hair ornaments should be limited to small barrettes, headband, clips, or bows.
- No cosmetics, lip-gloss, colored Chapstick, nail polish, eye makeup, lipstick, acrylic nails, and French manicures are permitted in any grade.
- No Hologram contact lenses and no body piercing, except pierced ears, are allowed. Body altering of any type is not permitted including, but not exclusive to, writing on body or clothing.
- ALL uniform items are to be of the correct size. No oversized or undersized clothing is permitted. Uniforms must be worn properly—shirts and blouses must be neatly tucked in and not rolled over the top of pants or shorts. Pants and shorts must be worn at the waist.

Jewelry Policy—Boys and Girls

- Christian religious medal or small cross on a thin plain gold or silver chain around the neck
- One watch
- One ring per hand
- Girls may wear one small stud earring per earlobe—no hoops or dangling earrings
- One small bracelet
- Boys may not wear earrings

Note: It is advisable for students not to wear jewelry on P.E. days. The P.E. teacher may request a student remove jewelry for the student’s safety. Students should not wear valuable jewelry to school. SPCS is not responsible for lost or stolen jewelry. All uniform regulations and guidelines are subject to the discretion of the Principal.

Uniform Company. The two primary uniform companies for SPCS is Flynn and O’Hara (www.flynnohara.com) and New Bern Sporting Goods (info@nbsports.net). Both companies encourage online ordering. Enforcement of Dress Code. Daily and weekly uniform checks will be made. Students not in uniform will receive a Dress Code violation. Students in PreK-3 through 4th grade will lose recess time for repeated infractions. Students in 5th - 8th grade will be assigned to Deacon’s Detention. Parents will be called to bring the correct uniform or students may be sent home to change into the correct uniform. This will reflect on the Conduct Area on the Report Card for “Following School Rules.” Continued disregard of the Dress Code policy will result in one-day in-school suspension.

Out-of-Uniform Days. Students should wear casual, appropriate attire. NO cut or torn clothing is allowed.
